




Report Page Tooltips

Report Page Tooltips

- Design a report to be used as a custom tooltip for other visuals
- A new page size template called **Tooltip** to use as a starting point
- Mark the page as a tooltip so Power BI can recognize it as such
- Feature is in preview mode so you will need to turn it on
- Not supported when viewing reports in mobile apps or embedded environments, including Publish to web
- Not supported for custom visuals





Bookmarking and Syncing Slicers




Bookmarking

- Generally available as of March 2018
- Can be used for anything from story telling to app-like navigation
- Custom visuals published by Microsoft on AppSource support bookmarking
- Capture the currently configured view of a report page, including filtering and the state of visuals, and later let you go back to that state by simply selecting the saved bookmark
- Create a collection of bookmarks, arrange them in the order you want, and subsequently step through each bookmark in a presentation to highlight a series of insights, or the story you want to tell with your visuals and reports.



Synchronize Slicers

- Synchronize slicers across multiple report pages
- You can specify whether each slicer should be applied to each individual report page, and whether the slicer should be visible on each individual report page
- You can apply multiple slicers to various pages and use the **Sync Slicers** pane to define how each slicer is individually applied across the various pages in your report
- While your selection of slicers can be synchronized, other selections such as styling, editing, and deleting are not synchronized






Quick Measures and Power BI with Excel



Quick Measures


- Beginning with the February 2018 release of Power BI Desktop, quick measures are generally available (no longer in preview)
- Quickly and easily perform common, powerful calculations
- Runs a set of DAX commands behind the scenes (you don't have to write the DAX – it's done for you) based on input you provide in a dialog box
- You can see the DAX that's executed by the Quick measure and jump-start or expand your own DAX knowledge





Power BI and Excel

- Analyze in Excel: View and interact with a dataset you have in Power BI in Excel – requires a Pro licenses
- Power BI publisher for Excel: Take snapshots of your most important insights in Excel, like PivotTables, charts, and ranges and pin them to dashboards in Power BI
- You can select a range of cells from a simple sheet or table, a PivotTable or PivotChart, illustrations and images, text
- Power BI publisher for Excel is an add-in you can download and install on desktop versions of Microsoft Excel 2007 and later
- Connect directly to data in the Power BI service and analyze that data in Excel using PivotTables and PivotCharts
