Dimensions: Redesigned in NAV2013

<u>Advantages</u>

- Lighter data footprint in database all combinations represented by set ids
- Less dimension tables to keep in sync (only the set id and two globals are posted)
- Optimized posting performance

<u>Disadvantages</u>

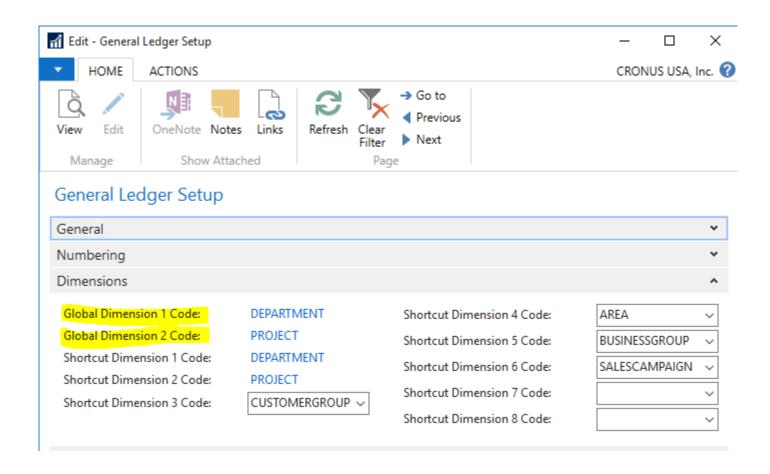
- Need to migrate data when moving from older NAV versions through NAV2013 (one-time, time consuming process)
- Cleaning up history through code can be trickier in some cases

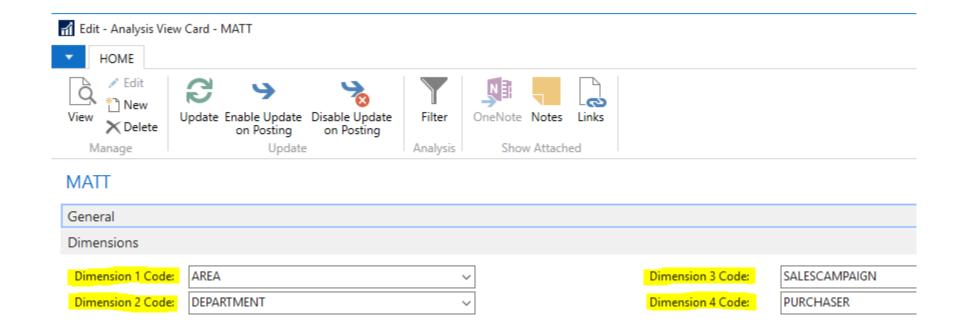

2 Global Dimensions



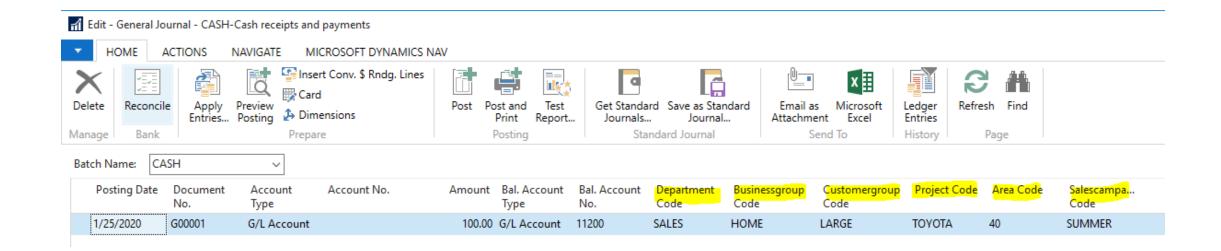


4 Dimensions per Analysis View

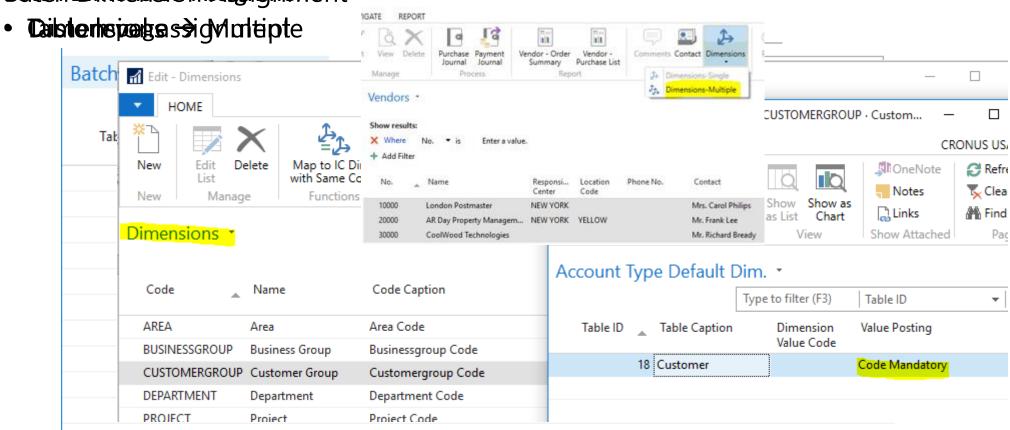

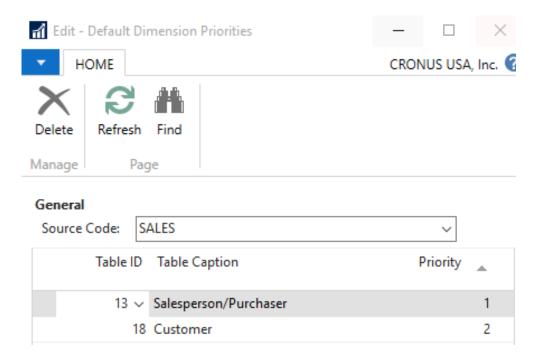

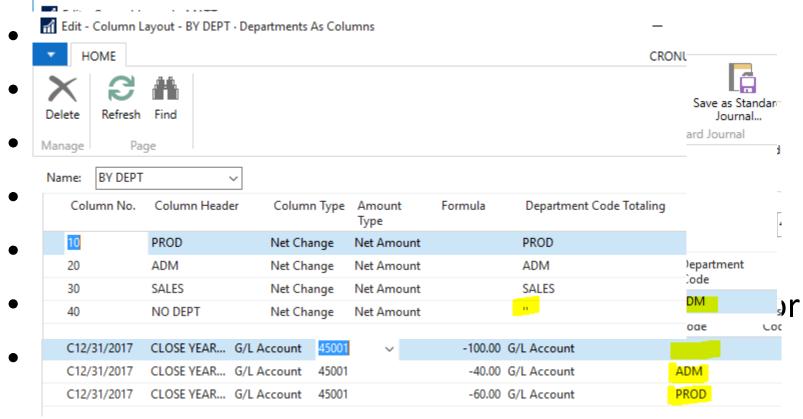
