


Why account schedules?

- Lines / Formulas
- Columns: Periods / Dimensions / Budget / Difference
- Working with Dimensions and Analysis Views
- Export to Excel



Customizations to Replicate

- "Flipping the sign"
- Filtering
- Finding "% of ..."
- Grouping
- Show only if not \$0





Jet Express

- Free
- Excel Add-In
- Real Time Reporting
- Ad hoc queries





Jet Express and Finance Reporting

- Pros
 - Filtering
 - Global Dimensions
 - Displaying table results in Excel
- Cons
 - Unable to keep custom fields
 - Unable to re-format





Jet Professional

- Power users are your friend
- Cost
- Security: Viewers/Designers
- Jet Scheduler
- Drilldown
- Control over formulas and functions down to the cell





Jet Professional and Finance Reporting

Pros

- Formatting
- Filtering
- Formulas/functions
- Drilldown
- Cons
 - Manual entry of accounts
 - Price
 - Complex reports can take long to run



Jet Professional



Jet Enterprise

- Date Warehouse
- Tuned for Performance (Cubes)
- Jet Data Manager
- Popularly used in conjunction with PowerBI
- Great for Dashboards/Slicers





Jet Express + Pivot Table

• Pros

- Filtering
- Formatting
- Grouping
- Custom formula values
- Includes new accounts by default

• Cons

- Custom formula totals
- "Percent of" calculations





Jet Express + Power Query + Pivot Table

Pros

- Like having your own cube
- Able to make customizations behind the scenes
- Custom columns
- "Percent of" columns

• Cons

- May need to refresh multiple times
- Need to set up your report in three different areas





SQL + PowerQuery + Pivot Table

Pros

- Like having your own cube
- One refresh (can refresh on opening)
- Includes new accounts by default
- Cons
 - Table linking
 - Set up









SQL + PowerBl

- Easy to use
- Visually appealing
- Very popular
