


RTC Capabilities — what can we exploit?

- Profiles divide the users into groups that experience different views of the system
- Customization is available at the Company, Profile and User level
- Customization provides users situational awareness by reducing clutter and organizing data
- One person's clutter is another's must have
- Add complex data back into the Page with FactBoxes
- Send Notifications or Page Links to other users
- Display data with Charts

Page Customization – This is Development

Benefits

- Fine Control
- Changes are across all Profiles
- Add Code to respect the phases of the moon
- Fall back behavior, no jammed up pages

Drawbacks

- Execution cost
- Upgrade cost
- Required Skills
- Tips Don't delete fields, just change visibility

Benefits


- Low cost







Profiles are not Security Groups

- Profiles help to control what is presented to the user
- The Departments Menu may be used to launch most of NAV watch out
- Different users may share the same profile and have completely different security needs
- The penalties for using many Profiles are minimal
- The penalties for using many Security Groups are high




The Security component - User Card





Benefits


- Links are generated to specific records

- If Security Groups are used then multiple recipients may be used

- Minimal visibility of history
- Not integrated with Comments
- Copy Link to Page may be what you need





Customize the Role Center Page – Add a Blank Chart




Selecting a Generic Chart to put in the Chart Part









